Criminal Justice Data Group
Team Member

1992 - 2004

The legislature created a high level policy group that created the data group to carry-out the legislative mandate to plan, solicit funding and administer statewide efforts to increase the completeness, timeliness and accuracy of criminal justice community data.

Criminal and Juvenile Data Modeling
Research Team Member

1994 - 1995

This effort developed a conceptual model for statewide criminal justice integration of data, which covers law enforcement, courts, and corrections activities for state, county and municipal government units.

1996 - 2004

The legislature created this task force to advise the criminal justice policy group, four criminal justice agency heads, on increasing the completeness, timeliness and accuracy of criminal justice community data.

The Office of Strategic and Long-Range Planning created this group to monitor and recommend strategies on how data will be used in research projects.

Department of Corrections Commissioner Transition Team
Team Member

1996

Commissioner Fred LaFleur appointed a group to develop and implement activities to transition in a new management team, of which I was the only non-corrections member.

Department of Corrections Management 1996 - Present
Team Member

The management team is responsible for the daily operations and future planning for the \$700 million biennial budget.

Department of Corrections Overcrowding Task Force 1991 - 1993
Committee Member

Minnesota Department of Corrections formed this task force to determine the extent of state and local correctional overcrowding and recommend creative alternatives.

DWI Department Plan Coordinating Committee 2000 - 2001
Co-Chair

Minnesota Department of Corrections formed this committee with several subcommittees to develop a plan to incarcerate, supervise and treat DWI offenders.

DWI Sentencing Alternatives Task Force 1997 - 1999
Committee Chair

Established by the Department of Corrections, this task force of practitioners and DWI expertise developed recommendations on alternatives for repeat DWI offenders.

DWI Task Force 1992 - 1994
Committee Member

The Minnesota Law School has a on-going task force that monitors DWI trends and makes recommendations to the legislature and other policy makers.

Epidemiology Work Group 1992 - 2004
Group Member

The Department of Health created this work group to share research on drug usage and statewide trends in Minnesota.

Evaluation of Minnesota's Department of Corrections 1996 - 1997
Research Team Member

This group was created by Minnesota Planning in response to the legislature's mandate to evaluate Minnesota's Department of Corrections.

Search Institute gathered experts to determine the extent girls are involved in gangs and to develop alternatives to reduce girls involvement in gangs.

Information for Action
Committee Member

1994 - 1996

The Department of Health formed this group to provide justice and drug related data to local communities for making informed policy decisions on efforts to reduce crime and drug activity.

Information Sharing Group
Committee Lead

2006 - Present

The DOC has invited all state technical experts to participate in a quarterly information sharing group. As these agencies drive most of Minnesota justice systems, this group focuses on state technical projects and coordination between the state agencies.

2006 - Present

The Commissioner of the Office of Enterprise Technology asked me to chair a small group of high level professionals to propose an organizational structure, staffing plan, budget request and a strategic plan for the statewide effort to reduce state, local, and educational technology costs, including hardware, software, and technical consulting.

National Drug Consortium Effort 1992 - 1996
Committee Member

The Bureau of Justice Assistance used this group to monitor and develop methodologies to evaluate national efforts on drug trends and drug usage in America.

Need To Know/Prevention Intervention Committee 1994 - 1995

- The DOC established a team to review all department research and evaluation projects to ensure consistency within the department and that the projects have a sound methodology. In addition, the team makes recommendations to the management team on projects and proposed research topical areas.*

Sociologists of Minnesota Advisory Board
Committee Member

2006 - Present

This state advisory board for Sociologists the Minnesota organization plans the annual conference and publishes quarterly newsletters. In addition, the board is reviewing alternative approaches to integrating sociology into research, business, and public policy.

Statewide Standards for Sex Offender Management

The legislature required a report February 2007 on all standards for Minnesota community supervision, treatment, and polygraph testing of sex offenders, which is developed from 4 working groups working two years, with over 60 representatives of all correctional delivery systems in Minnesota.

Short-term Offenders Committee
Statewide Lead

2007 – 2008

The legislature required a report January 2008 from a multi-member task force on the issues, problems, and potential solutions for the short-term offenders. In 2004, the legislature short-term offenders, offenders with actual prison time of 6 months or less, to be housed in a local jail at the counties expense. This group reviewed issues and determine potential solutions.
